## **Supervision Agreement**

I offer an integrated confidential supervision service, operating within the BACP ethical framework and within legal requirements. This means that what we discuss within our session will remain with myself within the following limits:

Certain rules apply to confidential practice which require the breaking of confidentiality. These areas are: safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults, terrorism, money laundering, drug trafficking, and risk of harm to yourself or someone else. I will endeavour to discuss any need to break confidentiality wherever possible. I wish you to feel free and safe to discuss anything you need to, and there is not always a need to break confidentiality in all cases. There may be a need for me to break confidentiality as a supervisor to act on behalf of your clients based on the above boundaries.

All counsellors/supervisors seek professional supervision (to allow them to offer you the best service), these supervisors are also bound by this confidentiality and all work discussed is anonymous. Anonymised supervision notes (by number rather than a name) and counsellor details are stored separately, securely and electronically, these are deleted after 6 years. You are consenting to the storage of these.

The price for each session will be £45 per hour full price or £40 for concessions (1.5hours full price will be £65)

Payment is required at the time of the session (on the same day or prior if by bank transfer).

Cancellation needs to be 24hours before the session or you may be charged £20 administration fee for the session (this includes failure to attend sessions). Equally I will attempt to give you as much notice as possible if I should need to cancel the appointment for unforeseen circumstances.

Session times will be an agreement between supervisee and supervisor based on their availabilities. You are free to end our supervision arrangement at any time. Session are non-refundable.

Your supervisor reserves the right to end the therapeutic relationship if they feel it ethically necessary. If you wish to discuss anything about this contract please do not hesitate to ask.
